




OUR TOURS

THE BEAUTY BENEATH YOUR BOOTS

Guided tours through Caverns of Sonora depart from the visitor's center in groups of 12 or less throughout every day except Christmas Day. The historic section is seen as you enter the site of the original, natural entrance. The tour then progresses into the active, living area. Just a little less than 2 miles, the tour can be completed in 1 hour 45 minutes to 2 hours.

Special tour rates are available for groups of 12 or more by confirmed, advance reservation. Educational tours are available as are tax-exempt rates for schools, churches, scouts, and etcetera.





CAVE PHOTOGRAPHY
CLINIC + TOURS

Book our 3 hour photo tour and photograph the most beautiful show cave on the planet with a professional guide. Tripods, lights etc. are allowed. 2 weeks advance reservation is required for a minimum of 2, maximum of 4.



The Discovery Challenge is a 4 hour caving adventure. All necessary equipment is provided and an experienced caver will lead you into a maze of undeveloped cave passages where you will crawl, climb, and rappel. 2 weeks advance reservation is required for a minimum of 2, maximum of 6.

A great interactive class in the subterranean Caverns Hilton Room offers hands-on activities including a fossil dig. This classroom is most appropriate for grades K through 6 and lasts about an hour. Cave biology, geology, paleontology and speleology are covered during the slide show presentation.



UNDERGROUND CLASSROOM



Built in 1961, the visitor center is a ranch barn design with vaulted ceilings and exposed oak beams. Come in and explore! Just outside you'll find our native stone pavilion - built in 2016 and available for event or meeting rental.
